Dear Glen Eden Members;

Glen Eden continues in our efforts to protect the health and safety of all of our members. The threat of infection continues to be a major concern as the number of positive cases continue to increase.

On July 29, 2020, the Board of Directors unanimously passed an email motion to revise B20-167. The major modifications approved were discontinuing the weekend reservation requirement for non-site holder members and to allow members to remove their face covering when seated in a chair or lounge as long as there was at least 6 feet of social distancing.

**Revised COVID-19 Requirements:**

1. To reduce the threat of COVID-19 infection and limit social gatherings, access to the common recreation areas, including the main pool patio, tennis patio, and pickleball patio shall be reduced. Access to the common recreation areas will be limited to the number of chairs and/or loungers available (currently 35 in the main pool area and 12 in the new pool area).
2. Use of the Main swimming pool shall be limited to 16 people.
3. Use of the Indoor swimming pool shall be limited to 2 people.
4. Use of the Hot Tub shall be limited to 8 individuals.
5. Use of the Multi-Purpose pool shall be limited to 12 people.
6. Use of the Conversation pool shall be limited to 6 people.
7. No entertainment will be permitted.
8. Use of Rental units and RV hook-up sites will continue on a reservation basis. Rental unit reservations may be limited by management based on staffing availability.
9. Use of Dry Camp will be limited to 16 occupants.
10. Water Volleyball, Zumba, Outdoor Yoga, Ukulele Jam, Pottery Studio, Tennis, Pickleball, Volleyball, Outdoor Billiards, and Karaoke will be allowed to continue subject to approved mitigation plans.
11. The Bookstore, Naked Needle Studio, Gym, and Library will remain closed.
12. Modifications to these restrictions may be made by the General Manager subject to changing State and County requirements and other needs that may impact effective implementation.

**The following requirements continue to be in effect:**

1. Physical distancing of at least six feet is required.
2. Facial covering is not an alternative to physical distancing of at least six feet.
3. Except for members of the same household, facial covering is highly recommended in all social gathering situations, including rental sites, even when physical distancing of at least six feet is being maintained.
4. Facial covering is required anytime six feet of social distancing cannot be maintained.

5. Facial covering is required when entering and exiting common recreation areas, including pools and spas. When using a chair or a lounge and six feet of social distancing is being maintained, facial covering may be removed but must be readily available to be deployed as needed.
6. Facial covering is required in pools and spas unless swimming laps.
7. Facial covering must be readily available to deploy should physical distancing not be possible. For example, when walking.
8. Exceptions to facial covering are provided within approved activity mitigation plans. For example, tennis, and pickleball.
9. Wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently.
