Greetings,

The purpose of this update is to inform GE members and guests regarding the actions we are taking in response to the increasing surge in COVID cases. On November 19, 2020, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued a "Limited Stay At Home Order". This order was issued in response to the unprecedented rate of rising COVID-19 cases across California. A second COVID surge is devastating much of the nation and is now becoming part of our experience in Riverside County. Additional guidance has also been sent out by CDPH regarding "Gatherings" and "Face Coverings".

The General Manager and I have spent many hours reviewing these documents with board members and officers. These immediate actions are being taken to help prevent the spread of the virus. We have stayed safe so far and our goal is to keep our members and guests safe from infection during the COVID surge that is upon us.

The Board has passed a motion to approve the following **Glen Eden COVID-19 Pause Plan**. The plan will be implemented, effective 10:00pm, November 21, 2020:

Glen Eden COVID-19 Pause Plan
Effective November 21, 2020 - December 21, 2020

General Provisions

1. GE Management will review and update as necessary each activity risk/mitigation plan. Our greatest concern continues to be maintaining 6ft of social distancing, wearing masks when in social situations except when actively eating, drinking, or in a pool or spa, and preventing surface contact infection by washing hands, using hand sanitizer and frequently disinfecting common use surfaces.
2. Curfew - Pursuant to the CDPH Order regarding a "Limited Stay at Home Order" Glen Eden residents are notified that all gatherings with members of other households and all activities conducted outside the residence, lodging, or temporary accommodation with members of other households cease between 10:00pm PST and 5:00am PST, except for those activities associated with the operation, maintenance, or usage of critical infrastructure or required by law.
3. Pursuant to the CDPH Guidance on Gatherings, Glen Eden residents are notified that "All private gatherings must be held outdoors. A gathering of no more than three households is permitted in a public park or other outdoor space".
4. Pursuant to CDC and CDPH guidance, face coverings should not be worn in pools or spas. Facial covering must be worn when entering or exiting a pool or spa and should be removed as long as 6ft of social distancing is being maintained.
5. GE short-term rentals and day use members will be permitted to continue under current risk/mitigation plans.
6. Prospective member tours will be postponed.

Activities Being Paused

1. Large group activities will be postponed. This includes the Fall Harvest Dinner and Comedy Show and the Turkey Trot Poker Run scheduled for November 28, 2020.
2. The indoor pool will be closed as indoor activities are not permitted.
3. Water Volleyball will be postponed.
4. Ukulele Jam will be postponed.
5. Karaoke will be postponed.
6. Zumba will be postponed.
7. Volleyball will be postponed.
8. Yoga will be postponed.
9. TaeKwonDo will be postponed.
10. Naked Needle Gang indoor activities will be postponed.

Activities Remaining Open with Modifications

1. Office - will remain open with current risk/mitigation procedures in place.
2. Cafe - will remain open for take-out orders. Only one customer allowed in the cafe at a time. Take out Thanksgiving Dinner will be available on November 26, 2020.
3. Bookstore - will remain open with updated risk/mitigation plan allowing one customer in the store at a time.
4. Library - will remain open with updated risk/mitigation plan allowing for one customer in the library at a time.
5. Outdoor pools and spas can remain open with appropriate 6 ft of social distancing maintained. No facial covering is required in pools or spas. However, facial covering must be worn when entering or exiting a pool.
6. Common areas will remain open with seating that accommodates 6ft of social distancing. Table, chair, and loungers must not be moved.
7. Water Aerobics will continue with no facial covering and required 6ft of social distancing maintained.
8. Art Studio will continue with 6ft of social distancing maintained and facial covering required.
9. Tennis will continue with approved risk/mitigation plans.
10. Pickleball will continue with approved risk/mitigation plans.

This plan may be modified if required by additional State or County requirements. Any changes with individual activities must include submission of a modified risk/mitigation plan for review and approval by management.

I know these are trying times. However, there is a light at the end of the tunnel. The vaccines that will soon be approved will take us out of the severe COVID restrictions we are having to live with. It is important to continue our efforts to keep Glen Eden safe and take all the steps we can to help lower the threat of infection. Your understanding and cooperation is greatly appreciated.
